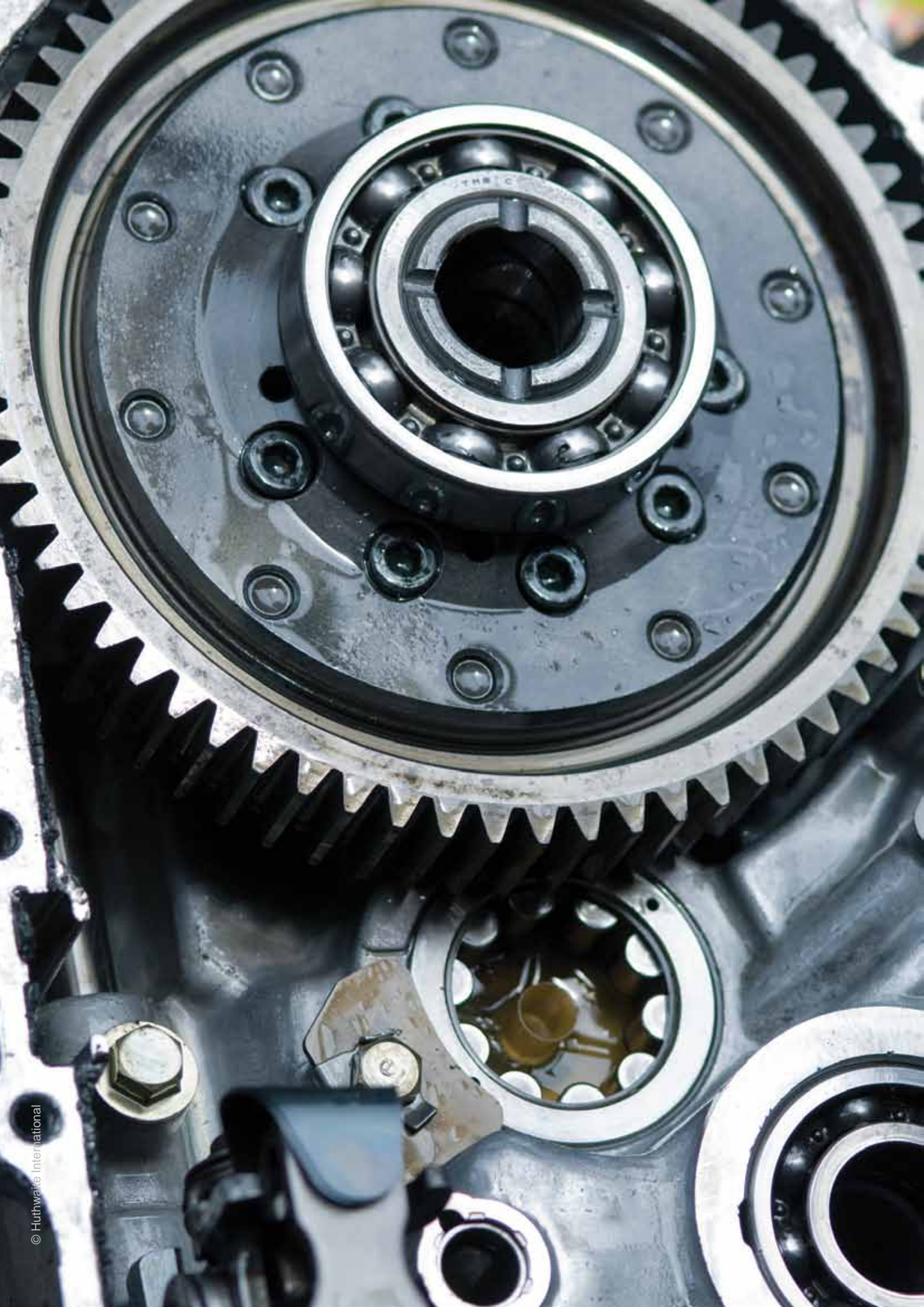


SKF implements **Trouble Free Operations** programme in forty-five countries
